Subject : No Gift Policy

(Policy against the acceptance of gifts or rewards for performing duties)

Fiscal Year 2025

According to the Cabinet resolution dated December 8th, 2020, approving the national reform plan in the areas of suppression and prevention of corruption and misconduct (revised edition), defining key reform activities. Activity 4 focuses on developing a transparent Thai bureaucracy, free of benefits. Goal 1, Section 1.1 states that all government agencies should declare themselves as units whereby every state official refuses gifts and rewards of any kind while performing their duties ("No Gift Policy"). Declare the strong intention to oppose all forms of corruption and misconduct, strengthening morality, ethics, and honesty while performing duties, which results in transparency in the management of public administration and operations of personnel, according to the principles of good governance. This policy focuses on performance of duties with honesty, integrity, transparency, and accountability, which will build confidence, faith, and trust in management to the service recipients. Therefore, all administrators and personnel of Suan Sunandha Rajabhat University are resolutely assigned to as follows:

1. Refuse to accept gifts and presents while performing duties.
2. Disclose information in a straightforward, verifiable manner, and provide opportunities for stakeholders to participate in the university's operations.
3. Focus on working with full efficiency to achieve the highest effectiveness and responsibility for performing work.
4. Act in moral, ethical and professional manner, and be considerate of the public interest over private interest.
5. Raise awareness and values of anti-corruption among personnel and students.
6. Work strictly in accordance with procedures, laws, rules, regulations, manuals, and work standards, adhering to the principles of accuracy, fairness, and non-discrimination.

The announcement shall be informed and observed accordingly.
