



## Announcement of Suan Sunandha Rajabhat University

**Subject:** Policy on not accepting gifts or gratuities of all kinds for performing duties  
(No Gift Policy) Fiscal Year B.E. 2569 (2026)

---

Suan Sunandha Rajabhat University is committed to administering its affairs in accordance with the principles of good governance, with the aim of fostering an organizational culture grounded in integrity, transparency, and the prevention of corruption and misconduct at all levels. Furthermore, the University seeks to prevent conflicts of interest and to avoid any undue burden or discomfort for both givers and recipients arising from the performance of duties by its executives and personnel.

By virtue of Sections 27 and 31 of the Rajabhat University Act B.E. 2547 (2004), in conjunction with Section 128 of the Organic Act on Anti-Corruption B.E. 2561 (2018), the University hereby issues the No Gift Policy for Fiscal Year B.E. 2569 (2026) as a guideline for practice, as follows:

1. All executives and personnel at every level shall refrain from giving or accepting gifts, gratuities, or any other benefits of any kind from all related parties, whether before, during, or after the performance of their duties. They shall also not seek to obtain such gifts, gratuities, or benefits in connection with their official functions, in order to uphold standards of integrity and good governance.

2. Executives and supervisors at all levels shall serve as exemplary role models and strictly supervise their subordinates to ensure compliance with this announcement. They shall also promote awareness and cultivate values that encourage firm opposition to all forms of corruption.

3. Executives and personnel shall perform their duties with honesty and integrity, upholding moral principles, ethics, and professional codes of conduct, with due regard to the public interest as a priority. They shall adhere to principles of correctness, fairness, and non-discrimination.

4. In cases of necessity, where the giving or receiving of gifts or gratuities is in accordance with tradition, custom, culture, or social etiquette, such actions must be subject to strict consideration of appropriateness and shall comply with the Regulations of the Office of the Prime Minister on Giving or Receiving Gifts of State Officials B.E. 2565 (2022), the Announcement of the National Anti-Corruption Commission on Criteria for the Acceptance of Assets or Other Benefits on an Ethical Basis by State Officials B.E. 2563 (2020), as well as all other relevant laws and regulations.

This announcement is hereby issued for general acknowledgment and strict compliance by all concerned.
